## **Adopt-A-Street Program Safety Recommendations**

The following safety recommendations are strongly encouraged as safety is of the utmost importance. All groups and individuals should consider them accordingly:

- 1. Carpool to the litter pick-up area, if possible, to keep vehicles to a minimum.
- 2. Park vehicles away from the roadway.
- 3. Keep work groups to a manageable size.
- 4. Closely supervise youth groups.
- 5. Do not remove any hazardous materials found on the site.
- 6. Stay clear of construction areas.
- 7. Do not pick-up litter on bridges and overpasses or in tunnels unless there is a safe passageway.
- 8. Hold safety meetings with groups prior to litter pick-up activities.
- 9. Do not pick-up litter during inclement weather, night-time, or hours of peak traffic.
- 10. Be aware of contact with poisonous plants, insects, ants, and snakes.
- 11. Consider the possibility of any participant's known allergies.
- 12. Do not partake of, possess, or distribute alcoholic beverages during a clean-up.
- 13. Make participants aware that they are working in a potentially dangerous environment and caution them to act accordingly.
- 14. Use gloves and/or grabbers.
- 15. Do not touch your face with gloved hands.
- 16. Stay hydrated.
- 17. Wear brightly colored clothing and/or reflective clothing similar to road construction workers.
